Dear Participant,

Phase 2 BISTECH Trading System testing environment running both Equity and Derivatives Markets is available starting from June 15, 2016 for free testing of members and software firms. Technical details required to connect to the testing environment are available on this document.

A - Essential Information Before Testing

Connection to the testing environment will be provided over current production networks. Our participants can avoid data traffic which can be a concern by planning their tests during hours with relatively less traffic instead of rush hours.

Although BISTECH production environment has an active-passive failover architecture for BISTECH FIX GWs, only an active FIX GW will be available in the testing environment.

Participants can request their user information for Phase 2 BISTECH Trading System testing environment from Help Desk on (+90 212) 298 24 27 or at bistechsupport_autoticket@borsaistanbul.com as of June 15, 2016. In order to avoid any confusion, it is important for our participants to specify for which testing environment (Phase 1/ Phase 2) they request their user information.

Connection with FIX:

- ➤ Port information as well as username and password will be given for FIX connections. Connection port info will be separate for each participant.
- > There are two trading partitions on the testing environment. Trading partition separation is shown in the table below. Clients to run tests are required to connect to the both partitions with different users. IP's of the both partitions will be identical but port information is different. For this sake, two users and two port numbers will be given to clients related to FIX order transmission.

Connection with OUCH:

- ➤ OUCH will be available for Equity Market on the testing environment. For the OUCH connection, clients are required to connect to two partitions separately with different users as in the FIX connection. Trading partition separation shown above for the FIX connection is valid for the OUCH connection as well. Partition information can also be retrieved via FIX RD. Due to two partition structure, port information related to both partitions and two user details shall be shared upon request.
- ➤ Members will be informed about OUCH availability for Derivatives Market in the testing environment later on.

Connection with ITCH:

➤ For the ITCH and Glimpse connection in test environment, again there are two trading partitions. Distribution of instruments to the partitions is the same. Port information related to both partitions and two user details for ITCH/Glimpse shall be shared upon request.

PTRM:

➤ Pre Trade Risk Management (PTRM) system will not be available in the testing environment for the first stage. It is planned to integrate PTRM system to the testing environment in the following weeks. Members will be informed about the inclusion of PTRM system later on.

End of Day Reports:

➤ End of day reports will not be available in the testing environment for the first stage. It is planned to publish end of day reports for the testing environment in the following weeks. Members will be informed about the inclusion of end of day reports later on.

B - Test Data and Trading Hours

End of day data of June 10, 2016 shall be used in the testing environment. After the first data uploaded, price information is going to be shaped as a result of trades made in testing

environment and those prices shall be transferred to following trade days. For instrument which is going to be used for testing, it is required to get updated partition and price information via FIX RD test connection.

Members and software firms willing to run tests for Market Marker activities are required to apply via bistechsupport_autoticket@borsaistanbul.com e-mail address for their market marker definitions to be made.
